Important Achievements in chronological order:
Juan Gallego-Coín, was born in Granada, Spain.
Gave his first recital at the age of nine.

At the age 11 was awarded the prize for musical composition of Andalucía by the Community Tourism Council of Granada.

During 1997/98 studied with Aquiles Delle-Vigne, a disciple of Claudio Arrau at the György Cziffra at the prestigious School of Musici Artis, in Brussels. During the same period worked under tutelage with Joaquín Achúcarro (1997).

Between 1993 and 2006: presented both solo performances and with orchestras in Spain, Belgium, France, Portugal, Japan, Algeria and Mexico with directors such as M. Sánchez Ruzafa, Josep Pons, Nic Raine, A. Salmerón. Some of the Orchestras Juan Gallego-Coín has performed include the City Orchestra of Granada (OCG), The Chamber Orchestra of Murcia.

Many of his performances have been recorded by the Radio National of Spain (RNE) Classical, the equivalent of Radio 3 of the UK, and Cope Radio.
